

**PERMIT CONDITIONS FOR INTRASTATE MOVEMENT OF UNROASTED  
COFFEE BEANS FOR ROASTING  
(Pre-Departure Fumigation Treatment)**

Restricted Article: Unroasted coffee beans and used coffee bags moving from the quarantine zones to areas of the State not infested with Coffee Berry Borer (CBB).

1. Restricted articles from quarantine zones to areas of the State not infested with CBB shall be treated, prior to departure, with a chemical treatment approved by the PQB manager.
2. Restricted articles shall be secured immediately after treatment to prevent re-infestation during transit within a quarantine zone.
3. Each shipment shall be accompanied by an invoice or shipping manifest listing the amount and origin of the beans shipped and a certificate of treatment issued by a licensed fumigator.
4. Coffee processing facilities identified in the permit shall be checked periodically at the discretion of the PQB Manager. Samples may be taken and examined for the presence of any live pests.
5. Each shipment shall be inspected at the time of departure and upon compliance of shipping requirements, the inspector shall affix to the article or the container or to the delivery order in a conspicuous place thereon, a tag, label, or stamp to indicate that the article has been inspected and passed.
6. The permit may be revoked at any time if the above conditions are not met.
