

**PERMIT CONDITIONS FOR INTRASTATE MOVEMENT OF UNROASTED  
COFFEE BEANS FOR ROASTING  
(Pre-Departure Heat Treatment)**

Restricted Article: Unroasted coffee beans and used coffee bags moving from the quarantine zones to areas of the State not infested with Coffee Berry Borer (CBB).

1. The restricted article shall be removed from the coffee bag and heat treated at 315 degrees Fahrenheit for at least 5 minutes before shipping.
2. Heat-treated coffee beans shall be contained in a different type of bag, and the original coffee bag sterilized or destroyed.
3. Untreated coffee beans may not be co-mingled with the shipment of heat-treated coffee.
4. Plant Quarantine Branch shall be notified by fax at (808) 832-0584 before the shipment arrives at final destination with information stating the name of the shipper, importer, transportation carrier, date of arrival, and container or shipping number.
5. Each shipment of heat-treated coffee shall be subject to Plant Quarantine Branch inspection and shall be accompanied by an invoice listing the amount of beans being shipped (bags/pounds) and documentation from treatment applicator stating that the coffee was heat-treated at 315 degrees Fahrenheit for at least 5 minutes.
6. Each shipment shall be inspected at the time of departure and upon compliance of shipping requirements, the inspector shall affix to the article or the container or to the delivery order in a conspicuous place thereon, a tag, label, or stamp to indicate that the article has been inspected and passed.
7. The permit may be revoked at any time if the above conditions are not met.
