

**PERMIT CONDITIONS FOR INTRASTATE MOVEMENT OF UNTREATED
COFFEE BEANS FOR ROASTING PURPOSES
(Approved to Receive Restricted Article)**

Restricted Article: Untreated and unroasted coffee beans moving from (1) the primary zone to the secondary quarantine zone or; (2) the primary and secondary zones to areas of the State not infested with Coffee Berry Borer (CBB).

1. Intrastate movement of all restricted articles shall be limited to a Plant Quarantine Branch (PQB) approved processing facility that is five miles away from a coffee-growing area.
2. Restricted articles that have already been graded and certified shall be double sealed in plastic bags at least 4 millimeters thick. The bags shall be made of a transparent plastic to allow for visual inspection of primary containment bag to ensure integrity of coffee certification. Labels to identify the unroasted seed as being from a specific quarantine zone must be visible without breaching the outer bag.
3. Each shipment shall be inspected at the time of departure and upon compliance of shipping requirements, the inspector shall affix to the article or the container or to the delivery order in a conspicuous place thereon, a tag, label, or stamp to indicate that the article has been inspected and passed.
4. Restricted articles shall not be sold, given away or transported out of the locked (or safeguarded) storage area except for processing of the beans at location identified in the permit.
5. Restricted articles shall be held and safeguarded from other unroasted green coffee in a PQB approved area that can be easily disinfested until roasting.
6. All packing material and bags that came in contact with restricted articles shall be treated or disposed of, in a manner approved by the PQB, to prevent the spread of CBB.
7. Department of Agriculture PQB inspectors shall be allowed access to the holding/safeguarding area identified in the permit and to the roasting area to confirm compliance with permit conditions.
8. Records of movement of restricted articles under permit shall be made available to PQB inspectors.
9. The permit may be revoked at any time if the above conditions are not met.
