

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATORS OF SECTION 18 SPECIFIC EXEMPTION OF PRIAXOR XEMIUM FOR USE AGAINST *Hemileia vastatrix TO REDUCE* COFFEE LEAF RUST

The following are **REQUIREMENTS** for use of Priaxor Xemium for control of *Hemileia vastatrix* under the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Section 18 Specific Exemption:

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
- The specific exemption labeling and the entire Priaxor Xemium brand fungicide container label, EPA Reg. No. 7969-311, must be in possession of the user at the time of application. Read the container label before applying.

HDOA/PESTICIDE BRANCH NOTIFICATION

The Hawaii Department of Agriculture (HDOA) requires notification by <u>all</u> applicators of Priaxor Xemium for control of *Hemileia vastatrix*.

Submissions may be made via email or hard copy through mail.

Notifications must be submitted to HDOA at least <u>seven (7) days</u> prior to application.

Notifications shall require the following information:

- 1. Name of applicator
- 2. Phone number
- 3. E-mail address (if applicable)
- 4. Name of farm
- 5. Farm address, location, or Tax Map Key (TMK)
- 6. Acreage
- 7. Estimated date of application
- 8. WPS training completion date (if applicable):

HDOA/PESTICIDE BRANCH USE REPORT

The Hawaii Department of Agriculture (HDOA) requires a use report by <u>all</u> applicators of Priaxor Xemium for control of Hemileia vastatrix. Submissions may be made via email or hard copy through mail. Reports must be submitted to HDOA within <u>ten (10) days</u> of application.
